How do I book in

Contact us via email or phone. You will need to pay a \$200 deposit with the balance due on the first day of the course. Once we have received deposit we can then send you out your manual so you can start studying. Making a confirmed booking on this course indicates your intention to complete all the prior home study, acquire all the necessary equipment that you will need to complete the course and understand that any additional training will be at your expense if necessary. If you have any questions, please contact us before you book so you can be sure you have everything you need to commence the course.

Pre-requisites

- Minimum age 18
- Minimum Advanced Open Water Diver Certified
- TDI Nitrox Diver Certified or equivalent
- · Provide proof of a minimum of 25 logged dives

Location Options

Rosebud - You come to us. Course fees include 6 dives. *(See below for accommodation)* Mt Gambier - We head to cave country. Must be a member of CDAA. *(See below for accommodation)* Interstate - We come to you. Boat dives not included in fees. Must provide accommodation, boat dives & airport transfers for instructor.

Medical Statement

Please read carefully the medical statement attached with this email. If you answer **YES** to any of the questions on the statement you **MUST** provide the instructor with a Diving Medical which is within 12 months of the commencement of the course prior to beginning the course.

Course Content

- Duration of course is 4 full days
- A theory session
- Completion of the TDI Advanced Nitrox & Decompression Procedures Course written exam
- 6 Open Water Dives

Schedule

Day #1 - Introduction, Theory, Equipment assembly & critique, Plan dives Day #2 - Dive 1, Dive 2 Day #3 - Dive 3, Dive 4 Day #4 - Dive 5, Dive 6 (Please note: Schedule is only approximate. Depending on time or location the schedule may change)

Training Materials

You will receive as part of your fees the TDI Advanced Nitrox Online Access Code and the TDI Decompression Procedures Online Access Code. You are expected to complete the online theory for the Advanced Nitrox & Decompression Procedures portion of the course before the first day of the course. We advise that you book into the course at least 2 weeks prior to the commencement day to allow you sufficient time to complete the home study.

Equipment

You will require the following equipment to complete the course. Although we can hire you some equipment, we strongly recommend you own all of the equipment on this list:

- · Bottom mix cylinders Back mount (Manifolded or Independent) or Sidemount
- · Decompression mix cylinder 1 cylinders, minimum of 40cf each with full rigging and stage regs
- · Regulators for back/sidemount cylinders. One reg set must be equipped with a 2m long hose
- All reg sets must be DIN
- · BCD Harness system able to accommodate twin back mounted/sidemount cylinders and 2 stage cylinders
- Timing options: 2 Computers or 1 Computer & 1 Bottom timer or 2 Bottom Timers
- (Mixed Gas Computers preferred)
- · Light system (If course is run in a cave/sinkhole you will require 1 main and 2 backup lights)
- Lift Bag or SMB with Reel or Spool (Reel must have at least 45m line. You can have both)
- · Appropriate wetsuit or drysuit for conditions
- · 2 Slates (Recommend 1 wrist & 1 small pocket style)
- · Line cutting devise
- Spare mask
- · Large roll of white or grey gaffer tape
- · Small roll of white electrical tape
- 2 Black Permanent Markers (1 thick & 1 fine)
