How do I book in

Contact us via email or phone. You will need to pay a \$300 deposit with the balance due on the first day of the course. Once we have received deposit we can then email you your online code so you can start studying. Making a confirmed booking on this course indicates your intention to complete all the prior home study, acquire all the necessary equipment that you will need to complete the course and understand that any additional training will be at your expense if necessary. If you have any questions, please contact us before you book so you can be sure you have everything you need to commence the course.

Pre-requisites

- Minimum age 18
- TDI Advanced Nitrox & Decompression Procedures or equivalent
- Provide proof of a minimum of 50 logged dives
- or
- Minimum age 18
- TDI Air Diluent CCR Diver certified or equivalent
- · 30 hours on the CCR unit
- · Six months CCR diving experience

Location Options

Rosebud - You come to us. Course fees include 7 dives. (See below for accommodation) Mt Gambier - We head to cave country. Must be a member of CDAA. (See below for accommodation) Interstate - We come to you. Boat dives not included in fees. Must provide accommodation, boat dives & airport transfers for instructor.

Medical Statement

Please read carefully the medical statement attached with this email. If you answer YES to any of the questions on the statement you MUST provide the instructor with a Diving Medical which is within 12 months of the commencement of the course prior to beginning the course.

Course Content

- Duration of course is 5 full days
- A theory session / Unit Assembly
- Completion of the Unit Specific written exam
- 1 Confined Water Session
- 7 Open Water Dives
- 2 dives will be deco dives
- 420 minutes of Open Water bottom time

Crossover (Must already be a certified TDI Air Diluent Deco Procedures CCR Diver) Cost \$895.00

- Duration of course is 3 full days
- A theory session and Unit Assembly
- Completion of the Unit Specific written exam
- 1 Confined Water Session
- 3 Open Water Dives
- 1 dive will be a deco dive
- 180 minutes of Open Water bottom time

Training Materials

You will receive as part of your fees the TDI Generic CCR Online Access Code. You are expected to complete this online study prior to the beginning of your course.

Please ensure that you also have available ALL required manufacturers manuals and literature relating to the unit you will be diving on the course. This may be available from their website or you can contact us and we will email you the required information.

We advise you look over and familiarize yourself with this paperwork and the units components and it's functions as well as any manufacturers recommendations on assembly, use and post dive procedures. We advise that you book into the course at least 2 weeks prior to the commencement day to allow you sufficient time to complete the home study.

Equipment

You will require the following equipment to complete the course. Although we can hire you some equipment, we strongly recommend you own all of the equipment on this list:

- · A complete Rebreather to manufacturers specifications
- · Bailout cylinder 1 cylinder, minimum of 40cf with full rigging and stage reg
- Timing options as backups: 1 CCR Computer or 1 Bottom Timer
- · Light system (If course is run in a cave/sinkhole you will require 1 main and 2 backup lights)
- · Lift Bag or SMB with Reel or Spool (Reel must have at least 45m line. You can have both)
- Appropriate wetsuit or drysuit for conditions
- · 2 Slates (Recommend 1 wrist & 1 small pocket style)
- Line cutting devise & Spare mask
- Large roll of white or grey gaffer tape
- · Small roll of white electrical tape
- 2 Black Permanent Markers (1 thick & 1 fine)
- · Sofnolime 797 (12kg) or Cartridges
