


TDI CCR Mixed Gas Diver Course

Introduction

Thank you for enquiring about the [TDI CCR Mixed Gas Diver Course](#). The following information is designed to hopefully answer most questions you may have about how this course is run, the content, pre-requisites, equipment requirements and what you need to do to prepare yourself for the course.

How do I book in

Contact us via email or phone. You will need to pay a **\$300** deposit with the balance due on the first day of the course. Once we have received your deposit we can then send you the CCR Trimix Simplified Manual so you can start studying. Making a confirmed booking on this course indicates your intention to complete **all** the prior home study, acquire **all** the necessary equipment that you will need to complete the course and understand that any additional training will be at your expense if necessary. If you have any questions, please contact us before you book so you can be sure you have everything you need to commence the course.

Pre-requisites

- Minimum age 18
- TDI CCR Air Diluent Decompression Procedures Diver or equivalent
- Provide proof of a minimum of 50 logged dives with 50 logged hours (*Copy of dives must be submitted*)

Note: If diver has 50 hours on another unit, only 25 are require on this specific unit.

Location Options

Rosebud - You come to us. Course fees include 6 dives. (*See below for accommodation*)

Mt Gambier - We head to cave country. Must be a member of CDAA. (*See below for accommodation*)

Interstate - We come to you. Boat dives not included in fees. Must provide accommodation, boat dives, Sorb, gases, tank hire & airport transfers for instructor.

Medical Statement

Please read carefully the medical statement attached with this email. If you answer **YES** to any of the questions on the statement you **MUST** provide the instructor with a Diving Medical which is within 12 months of the commencement of the course prior to beginning the course.

Paperwork

Attached to this email are 2 documents that must be **read, understood and signed**. These documents must be presented on the first day of the course.

- Medical Statement Form
- Liability Release and Assumption of Risk Form

Course Content

- Duration of course is **4** full days
- A theory session
- Completion of the TDI CCR Mixed Gas Diver Course written exam
- **6** Open Water Dives
- **4** dives must be deco dives
- **360** minutes of Open Water bottom time

Schedule

- Day #1 - Introduction, Theory, Equipment assembly & critique, Dive 1
- Day #2 - Dive 2, Dive 3
- Day #3 - Dive 4, Dive 5
- Day #4 - Dive 6, Theory Exam

(Please note: Schedule is only approximate. Depending on time or location the schedule may change)

Training Materials

You will receive as part of your fees the [CCR Trimix Simplified](#). You are expected to read this manual prior to the beginning of your course and complete the Knowledge Reviews. You must also have available all manuals, checklists and documents relating to the rebreather you will be using on course.

Equipment

You will require the following equipment to complete the course. Although we can hire you some equipment, we [strongly recommend](#) you own **all** of the equipment on this list:

- A complete Rebreather
- Bailout cylinder - 2 cylinder, minimum of 80cf with full rigging and stage regs
- Timing options as backups: 1 CCR Trimix Computer [or](#) 1 Bottom Timer
- Light system (If course is run in a cave/sinkhole you will require 1 main and 2 backup lights)
- Lift Bag [or](#) SMB with Reel [or](#) Spool (Reel must have at least 45m line. You can have both)
- Appropriate wetsuit [or](#) drysuit for conditions
- 2 Slates (Recommend 1 wrist & 1 small pocket style)
- Line cutting device & Spare mask
- Large roll of white or grey gaffer tape
- Small roll of white electrical tape
- 2 Black Permanent Markers (1 thick & 1 fine)
- Sofnolime 797 (12kg)
