How do I book in

Contact us via email or phone. You will need to pay a **\$300** deposit with the balance due on the first day of the course. Once we have received deposit we can confirm your booking. Making a confirmed booking on this course indicates your intention to acquire **all** the necessary equipment and training materials that you will need to complete the course and understand that any additional training will be at your expense if necessary. If you have any questions, please contact us before you book so you can be sure you have everything you need to commence the course.

Pre-requisites

- Minimum age 18
- Be certified a Diver for a minimum of 6 months
- Provide proof of 100 logged dives completed in various different environments with varying depths
- Be certified as a SDI Divemaster, SDI Assistant Instructor or equivalent
- Provide proof of current CPR, First Aid and Oxygen Provider.
- SDI Computer Nitrox Diver or equivalent (Can be completed during this course)

Location Options

Rye - You come to us. (*See below for accommodation*)

Interstate - We come to you. Boat dives not included in fees. Must provide accommodation, boat dives, airfills, tank hire & airport transfers for instructor trainers.

Medical Statement

Please read carefully the medical statement attached with this email. If you answer **YES** to any of the questions on the statement you **MUST** provide the instructor with a Diving Medical which is within 12 months of the commencement of the course prior to beginning the course.

Paperwork

Attached to this email are 2 documents that must be **read, understood and signed**. These documents must be presented on the first day of the course.

- Medical Statement Form
- Liability Release and Assumption of Risk Form

A diving medical signed by a diving physician stating that you are fit for scuba diving activities completed within the last 12 months must also be provided.
